

Materials listed below make Blocks 1-12 for: 4 Runners each measuring 12½" x 57½" **OR** Throw Quilt measuring 48½" x 57½" Yardage is based on 42" width of fabric.

QUILT TOP FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric requirements below are based on pre-cutting all fabric with dimensions supplied in the individual pattern cutting charts. Each block will list requirements for each type of fabric — these amounts will account for a bit extra in case of a minor cutting mistake and are rounded up to a common yardage cut. The overall fabric requirements listed below are less than will be listed in the fabric requirements for individuals blocks when added up. The cumulative fabric requirements below assume that there will be some fabric leftover after piecing each block. You are also likely to have scraps that can be used in subsequent blocks. Depending on your paper piecing skills and piecing style, you may use more or less fabric.




